### ***COMMUNITY & SCHOOL DISTRICT***

Cinnaminson Township is located in Burlington County, NJ, bordering the Delaware River. An eastern suburb of Philadelphia with a total area of 8.1 square miles, Cinnaminson is a suburban community with a population of approximately 16,600. Cinnaminson school district is comprised of four schools including two elementary schools, a middle school, and a high school. While a vast majority of township students attend Cinnaminson High School, a small percentage attend Burlington County Institute of Technology or local private schools.

### ***MISSION STATEMENT***

The mission of the Cinnaminson School District is to educate our students and to assist their development into self-motivated, multi-faceted, happy, and physically fit individuals who are productive, responsible citizens. It is expected that all students will achieve the New Jersey Student Learning Standards at all grade levels. With national and state program standards as a basis, Cinnaminson students will gain an appreciation of knowledge, a desire to learn, and a respect for themselves and others. In partnership with the family and the community, we will foster achievement and we will model excellence and responsible behavior.

### ***ACADEMIC PROGRAM***

Cinnaminson High School is accredited by the Middle States Association and provides an extensive college preparatory program in which students are offered four years of English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Physical Education, and French or Spanish. Additionally, students can choose from a variety of electives in Art, Music, Business, Computer Technology, Marketing, and Foods. CHS also offers academic electives such as Forensic Science, TV Production, Gender and Society, Human Behavior, and Holocaust in Literature. CHS excels academically on various assessments. Several students have earned perfect scores on the SAT subject tests; CHS is proud to have several Commended Scholars in the National Merit Scholarship Program. Although CHS has just over 800 students, 392 AP exams were administered last year. Furthermore, CHS partners with Rowan College at Burlington County to offer the dual-credit College Acceleration Program (CAP). Additionally, World Language students have the opportunity to earn the NJ State Seal of Bi-literacy.

### ***EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS***

Cinnaminson High School offers a wide variety of Extra Curricular Sports, Activities, and Clubs, especially for a small suburban school. Our sports program offers 18 sports over three seasons, including Volleyball, Lacrosse, Field Hockey, and Bowling, in addition to staples such as Baseball, Football, and Wrestling. Of special interest is our Play Unified team, which is a partnership with Special Olympics. In addition to Choir, Drama, National Honor Society, and other high school standards, CHS boasts some rather unique clubs such as Battle of the Books, Friends of Rachel, Gay Straight Alliance, and Glamour Girls.

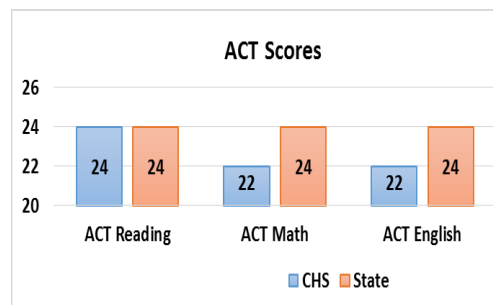
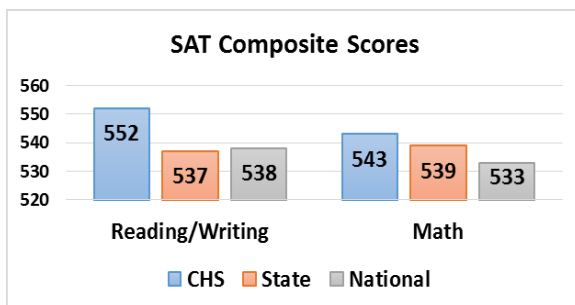

## GRADING/GPA/CLASS RANK

**GPA:** CHS calculates GPA on a 100 point scale. The final numerical grade is multiplied by credits earned to yield Quality Points. Ten additional points are added to Honors and AP classes prior to the quality points being determined. Accelerated Algebra 2 only earns 5 additional points. The sum of the quality points is divided by the total number of attempted credits to calculate the weighted GPA.

**Class Rank:** Calculated in September of senior year (6 semesters) and again at 7 semesters. Valedictorian and Salutatorian are assigned using the 7 semester class rank. Final class rank is run the summer after senior year.



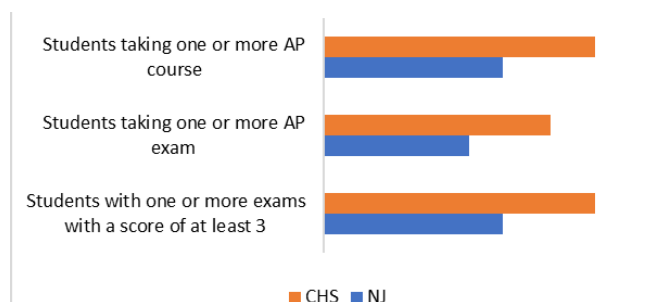

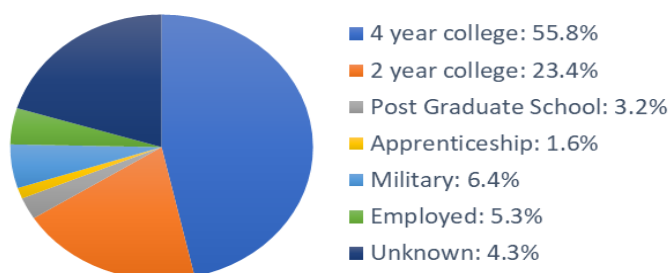
